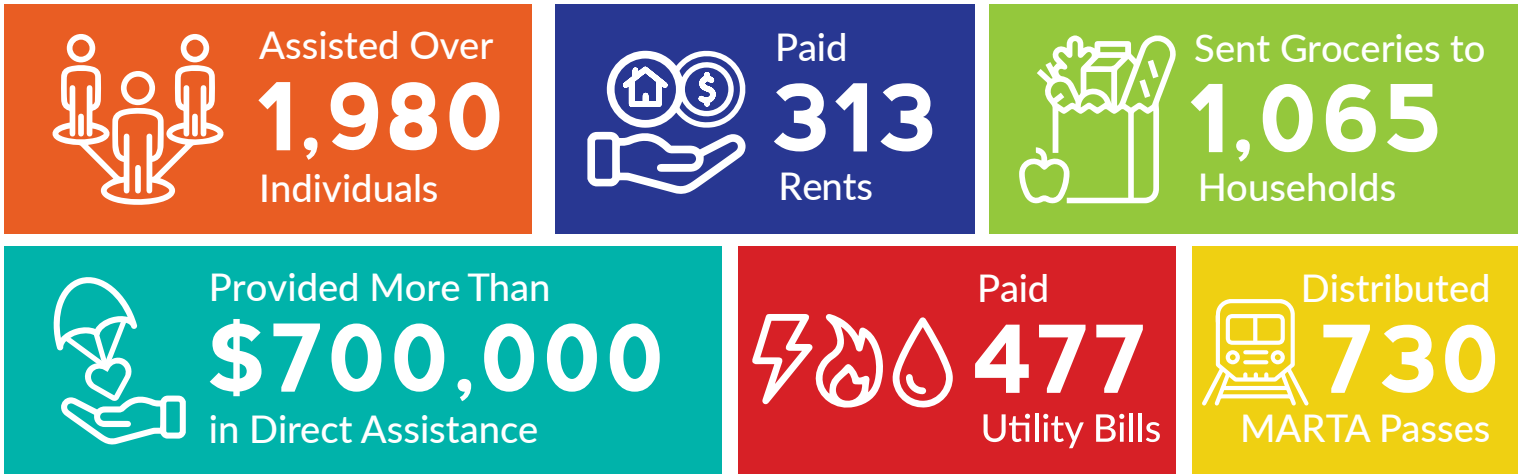

MAC is now located in heart of Midtown at 613 Spring Street. The new and completely renovated location offers more than two and a half times the square footage of its former home, with more space for client services, an expanded food pantry and additional space for staff and volunteers.

In the heart of Midtown, MAC's work is supported by 11 congregations, as well as the Midtown Alliance, many businesses, foundations, individuals, government entities, and volunteers. It is on the same block that is home to other community partners: All Saints' Episcopal Church, Covenant Community Ministries and Threads, a children's clothing ministry, further increasing outreach and service opportunities through this convenience to its clients.

The new, expanded home for MAC is a tenth of a mile from the North Avenue MARTA station, providing easy access for clients using public transportation.



MIDTOWN RACE FOR MAC



MAC's annual 5K draws hundreds of runners from around Atlanta to raise awareness about and combat homelessness and hunger for working families.

Race fees go directly towards MAC's mission of emergency assistance to prevent homelessness and hunger during periods of crisis, including through temporary rent or utility assistance to avoid eviction or disconnection, transportation to keep a job, or food on the table when times are lean.

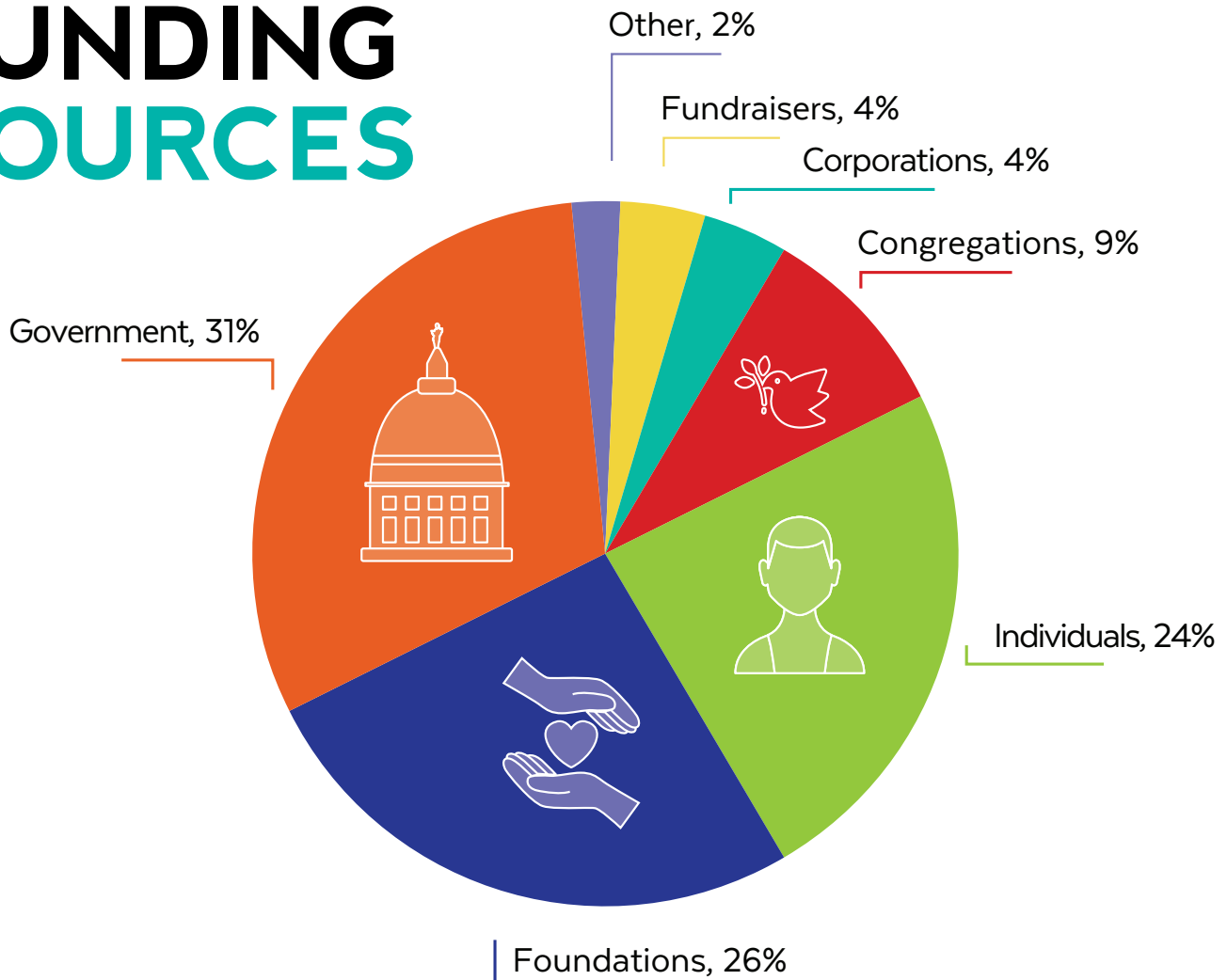
