
We are excited to announce MAC's 5K will return in Fall 2021. Be on the lookout for details soon!

MAKING THE TRANSITION - WORKING REMOTELY

When COVID-19 first shut down Georgia in March 2020, MAC was not set up to work remotely. We were designed to work in the office. Mailchimp had helped MAC set up a Request Help Google form for our website in 2015 which helped us keep some form of communication, but we were all working off one spreadsheet, had no way to take calls from clients, and did not have a way to access our files in the office. Our first instinct was that this was temporary, and we would be back in the office again soon. After a month it became clear that COVID-19 was not going away, and we needed to adapt.

In 2017 MAC worked with TechBridge to update our Salesforce data collection system and use iPads for client intake instead of paper card files. Although it was a challenge, we managed to make the change. We did not know at the time that it would be the make or break moment for MAC to adapt to working remotely.

As we struggled to adapt, the Form Assembly staff was a tremendous help, and even donated some private consultation hours to MAC to help design and troubleshoot some of the forms. With help from Salesforce and LAN Systems, we are now able to provide services from anywhere.



MAC staff evolved on the go and continued to find new ways to serve clients. Using electronic checks, food delivery services and gift cards, MAC has found new ways to deliver assistance to those in need.

We continue to be mindful of providing services remotely as we look towards being back in the office to serve in person. Whether remote or in person, one thing is clear - we have adapted and have more options to better serve the community.

COVID-19 ASSISTANCE HIGHLIGHT - GOVERNMENT FUNDERS

As with the rest of the world, we never imagined COVID-19 would impact us to the varying degrees we have experienced individually and collectively. The losses were significant, and complex, due to the many sectors that were shut down and overwhelmed by substantial need. This past year the MAC team listened to many stories from our neighbors in need who lost jobs and income, access to public transportation, health care, and family members and friends. As we listened to the stories of people calling for assistance we realized that the need was also being felt by people from higher income levels.

With our regular funding we would not have been able to assist many of these households because of higher rents and sizable past due rent. Because of special COVID-19 response funding we were awarded from **Fulton County** (\$450,000), the **City of Atlanta** via the United Way of Greater Atlanta, Emergency Rental Assistance (ERA) collaborative program (\$387,000), and **FEMA's Emergency Food and Shelter Program** (EFSP) we were able to work as a team to provide relief and offer other resources. The MAC team is grateful for all our donors and volunteers who helped to make this level of assistance possible. As we navigate into our "next normal", we will continue to hold in our thoughts our neighbors inneed who are still trying to find ways to survive their financial hardships. Thank you to our MAC friends and supporters for encouraging us and walking alongside us during these uncertain times. We are privileged to do this work!



JV Spotlight: Julia Goetz

As you all know, this year has been very different from any other. Even while working virtually for the first time, everyone at MAC has shown me so much support and immediately welcomed me into the community. I appreciate everyone's willingness and patience to teach me the ropes and check in with me virtually.

I was able to build meaningful relationships with the other volunteers and loved seeing their faces on screen every week. When we finally united in person at the volunteer picnic, it was so special to see everyone and connect face to face.

One of the best parts of my year was helping with the annual Christmas program. Even though the program was very different this year because of the pandemic, it was so great to provide children with Christmas gifts. Thanks to the donors and volunteers, we were able to give presents to children from their wish lists to make their Christmas even more special. While I wish I could meet my clients in person, I am grateful I can assist them with food and Marta over the phone. I feel incredibly lucky to work at MAC this year and be a part of all the great work MAC does every day.

Christmas Program Goes Virtual

More than six months into the pandemic, MAC staff and supporters knew Christmas wasn't going to look the same for many of our neighbors. Last year, more than ever, families needed something to celebrate. Thanks to donors, and dozens of service hours from our volunteers, we were able to sponsor 173 children with Christmas gifts. Using an online wish list, donors were able to purchase gifts and have them shipped directly to families' homes. We are grateful for all those who made Christmas morning special for so many children in our community.






