NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Birthdays and anniversaries are opportunities for celebration, reflection, and planning – celebrating successes, reflecting on challenges, and planning for the future. MAC’s Board of Directors, Staff, Volunteers, Friends and Supporters spent our 40th year doing just that. When reflecting over MAC’s 40 years, what stands out the most is the radical kindness of others which drives our ability to serve.

MAC was founded and built on the kindness of others. In MAC’s first years, the budget was very small. Longtime MAC volunteer, Elizabeth Robertson shared that it was not uncommon for a volunteer to step in and donate funds, so a neighbor in the waiting room could receive much needed food. Kindness put food on the table.

Under the leadership of Dorothy Chandler, kindness and generosity enabled MAC to grow to provide vital assistance to prevent evictions, utility disconnections, and hunger. Kindness kept people in their homes.

MAC’s 40th year of service saw drastic cuts to federally funded programs and inflation. The government shut down in October and November 2025 hit government workers and families who rely upon SNAP benefits. Without SNAP to purchase food, many were forced to make difficult choices between buying food/ medicine and paying their rent or utility bills. MAC saw an immediate increase in the need for food and financial services. Kindness showed up through emergency food donations and funding.

A gift from an anonymous donor and gifts in honor of our 40th anniversary provided MAC with funds to increase our capacity and reach underserved neighborhoods. MAC’s legacy was celebrated with the intention that there is more work to be done. Over the past 40 years, MAC has assisted the community during strong and difficult economic times. We’ve witnessed the need for services increase significantly due to economic and policy stressors. As a safety net for those who have none, there will always be an emergency – job loss, medical diagnosis, or other crisis – that leaves a neighbor on the verge of hunger, utility disconnection, or eviction. The need for MAC and organizations that support vulnerable populations will not go away.

As we enter our next decade, we remain committed to standing with our neighbors to provide the bridge support needed to maintain self-sufficiency and the opportunity to thrive. We cannot do it without you. Your kindness and generosity allow MAC to continue its work.

NOTE FROM THE BOARD PRESIDENT

On behalf of the Board of Directors, I am pleased to present Midtown Assistance Center’s Annual Report, marking MAC’s 40th anniversary of service to the Atlanta community.

Founded on the All Saints Episcopal Church block in 1986, MAC has spent four decades delivering critical assistance - including rent, food, clothing, transportation, and utility support - to residents of the Atlanta/Fulton County area.

This past year presented significant challenges, as economic uncertainty and rising unemployment drove increased demand for our services. Despite operating without government funding, MAC met that increased demand, with our dedicated staff and volunteers. In the first six months of 2026, MAC increased rent and utility assistance exceeding our budget by \$125,000. None of this would be possible without the steadfast generosity of our donors and community partners.

Many of you celebrated our milestone anniversary with the Big MAC Bash, honoring the enduring contributions of Dorothy Candler, MAC’s emeritus executive director.

We remain deeply grateful for your continued support. Looking ahead, we are committed to fulfilling MAC’s mission and are confident in our ability to meet the challenges before us - together.

40 YEARS OF IMPACT

For four decades, our commitment has remained unchanged:

Helping low-income working Atlantans overcome temporary setbacks before they become long-term crises.

In 1986, five Midtown congregations joined forces with the Midtown Alliance to create a new approach to helping Atlantans experiencing financial hardship. By combining resources and working together, they established the Midtown Assistance Center with a simple but powerful mission: to prevent homelessness and hunger during times of crisis.

What began as a collaborative effort to help working families pay rent, utilities, purchase work-related necessities, access transportation, and put food on the table has grown into a trusted community resource serving thousands of Atlantans.

For over 40 years, MAC has continued to prevent homelessness and hunger for low income, working Atlanta families experiencing financial crisis through rent, utilities, and food assistance.

Today, MAC operates from its home at 613 Spring Street in the heart of Midtown and is supported by twelve congregations, businesses, foundations, government partners, volunteers, and individual donors. Located near the North Avenue MARTA Station, MAC remains accessible to the community members who rely on its services.

As Atlanta continues to grow and change, MAC remains committed to ensuring that hardworking families have the support they need to remain stable, secure, and hopeful.

THE BIG MAC BASH CELEBRATING 40 YEARS OF IMPACT

For 40 years, Midtown Assistance Center has been a lifeline for hardworking Atlantans facing temporary financial crises. On February 28, 2026, nearly 300 supporters gathered at The Temple for our first-ever Big MAC Bash to celebrate four decades of preventing homelessness and hunger and to invest in the future of our mission.

The evening **raised more than \$200,000** to support MAC's Homelessness and Hunger Prevention programs, ensuring that families can remain safely housed, keep essential utilities connected, and access nutritious food when they need it most.



The celebration featured creative food stations inspired by the neighborhoods and zip codes we serve, live music from the Joe Alterman Trio, and a special tribute to Dorothy Chandler, MAC's Director Emeritus, whose leadership and advocacy helped shape the organization we are today.

Most importantly, the Big MAC Bash brought together the people who make our work possible—supporters, volunteers, congregations, community partners, and friends—reminding us that preventing homelessness and hunger is truly a community effort.

As we celebrate 40 years of impact, we are grateful for everyone who helped make this milestone event such a success. Together, we are building hope for the next 40 years.

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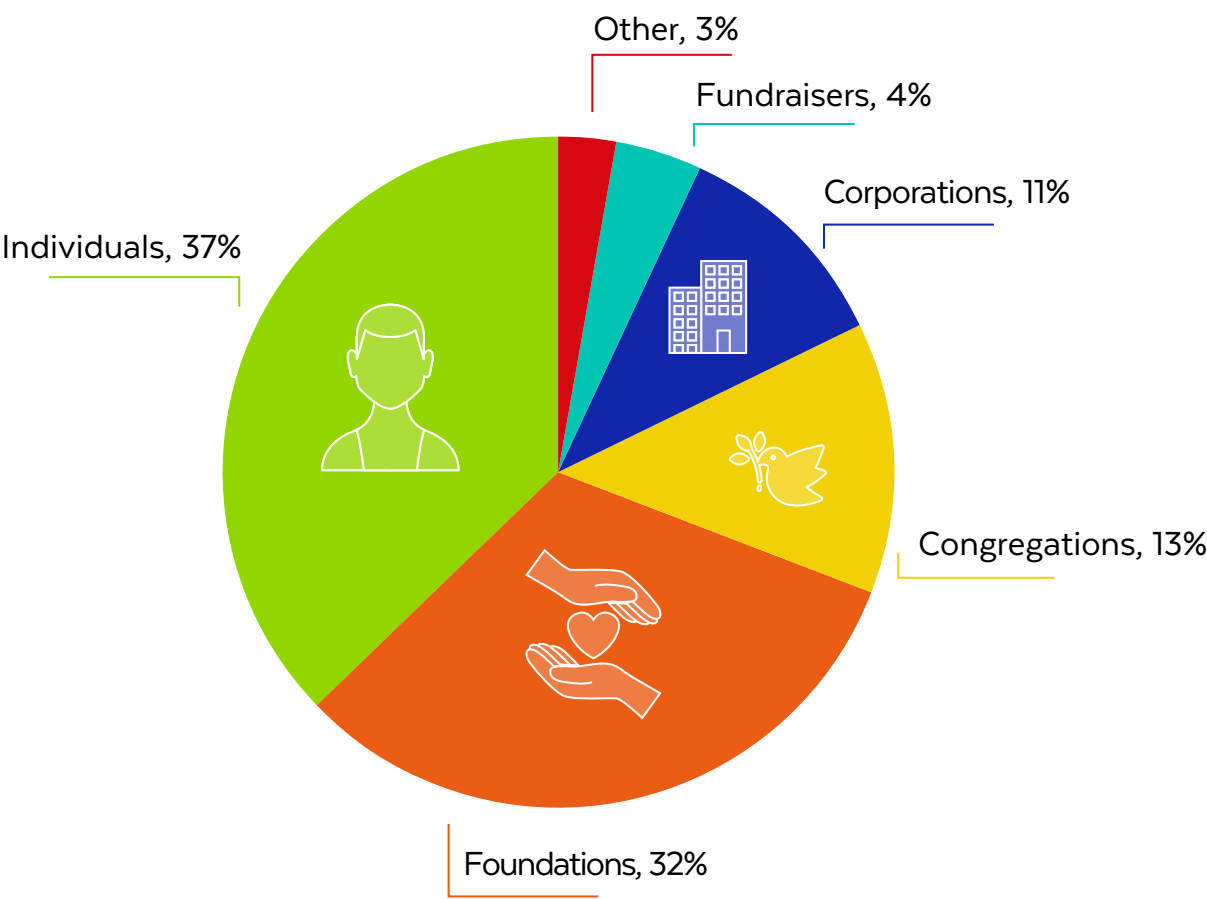
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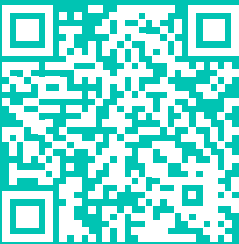


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
